

Teaneck's Butterflake Bakery to open second store nearby

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Butterflake Bakery, which opened in 1950, soon will have a second location in Teaneck. It will be at 444 Cedar Lane, near the original store.

The site will be used as a commissary and as a Passover retail location. Johnathan Greenberg, the director of Katz & Associates in Englewood, represented the bakery and the deal; NIA National Realty, Paramus, represented the landlord. The new space is slated to open in 2023.
